




12 Steps to Safe Motor Boating on Inland Waterways


## 12 STEPS TO SAFE MOTOR BOATING ON INLAND WATERWAYS







Beware of local hazards such as strong currents, weirs and low bridges.








Never drink and drive.



Make sure that you are safely tied up by dusk.

Navigation on inland waterways after dark can be hazardous.



Always use the chart. To avoid shallows, reefs and rocks always stick to the marked channel.



Beware of the dangers of fire and exhaust fumes on board, particularly when using petrol or domestic gas.



Ensure that your boat is seaworthy, your engine is regularly serviced and that you have enough fuel.
