Steps to Safe Swimming



Steps to Safe Swimming

1



Swim with others, never alone.

2



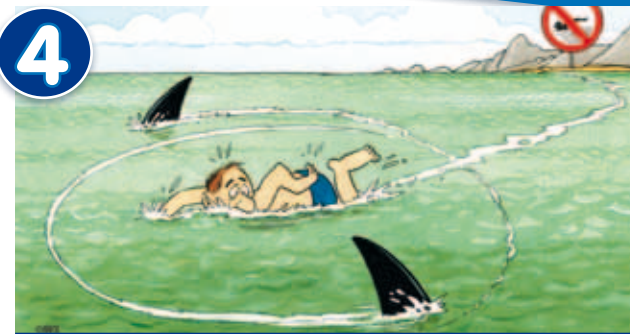
Don't swim just after eating.

3



Never swim in the dark or when you are hot or tired.

4



Avoid swimming in strange places.

5



Never swim out after drifting objects.

6



Don't stay in the water too long.

7



Don't swim out to sea.

8



Swim parallel and close to the shore.

9



Obey Lifeguards and swim between the Lifeguard Flags.
