- 2. Work completed in promoting Water Safety in **schools**;(15 Marks)
- 3. A new, **novel initiative** or special event used to promote Water Safety; (15 Marks)
- 4. Improved provision of lifesaving equipment; (10 Marks)
- 5. Improved maintenance and inspection of lifesaving equipment; (10 Marks)
- 6. Increase and improvement in **Lifeguard services** including increased lifeguard cover; (15 Marks)
- 7. **Public awareness** programmes; (10 Marks)
- 8. Increased **signage** in particular of dangerous bathing areas; (10 Marks)
- 9. Provision of **Byelaws** to improve Water Safety; (10 Marks)
- 10. **Donation or assistance** given to local voluntary Community Search & Rescue Services; (10 Marks)
- 11. Amount of resource allocated towards the inspection of **Public Rescue Equipment**; (10 Marks)
- 12. Improvement of facilities at **bathing areas**; (10 Marks)
- 13. Improvement of **swimming pool** facilities and water safety activities to the public for lifesaving and swimming instruction; (10 Marks)
- 14. **Other** appropriate contributions to and investments in water safety. (10 Marks)
