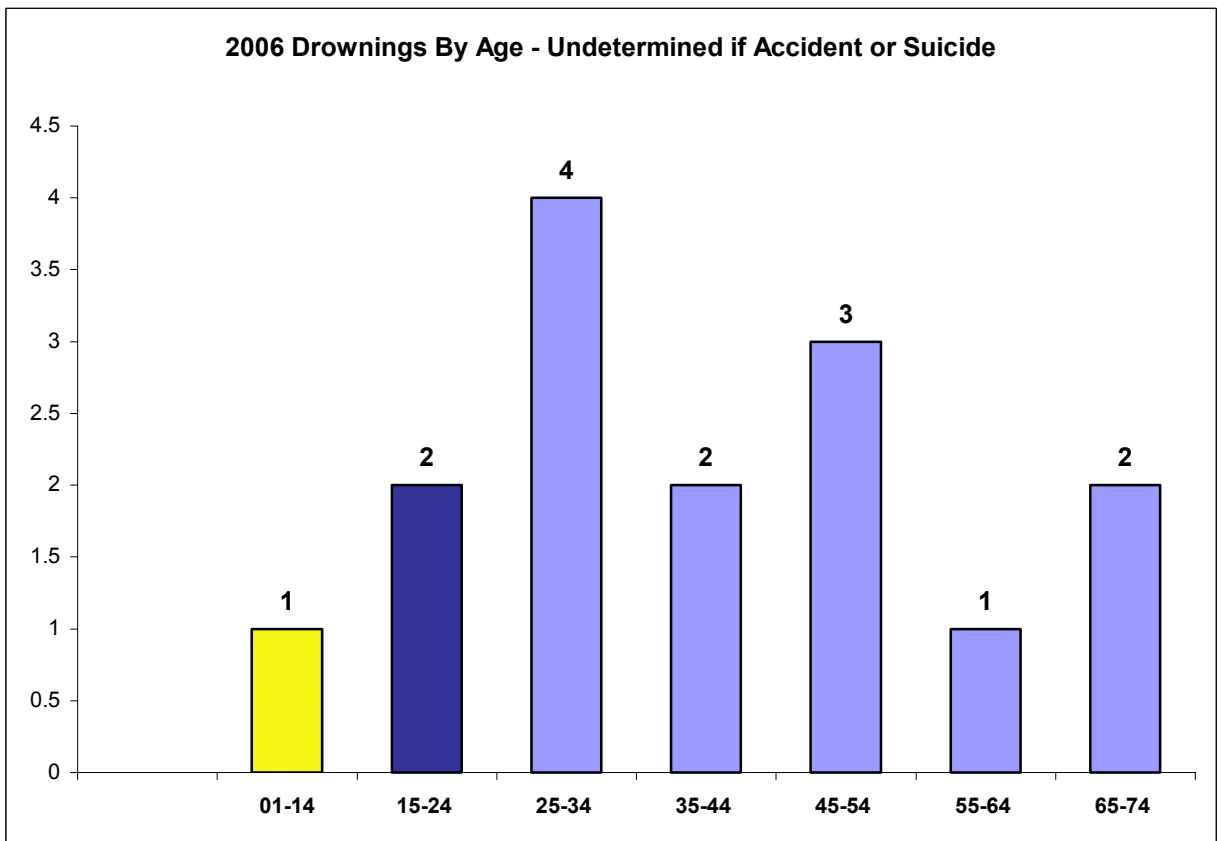
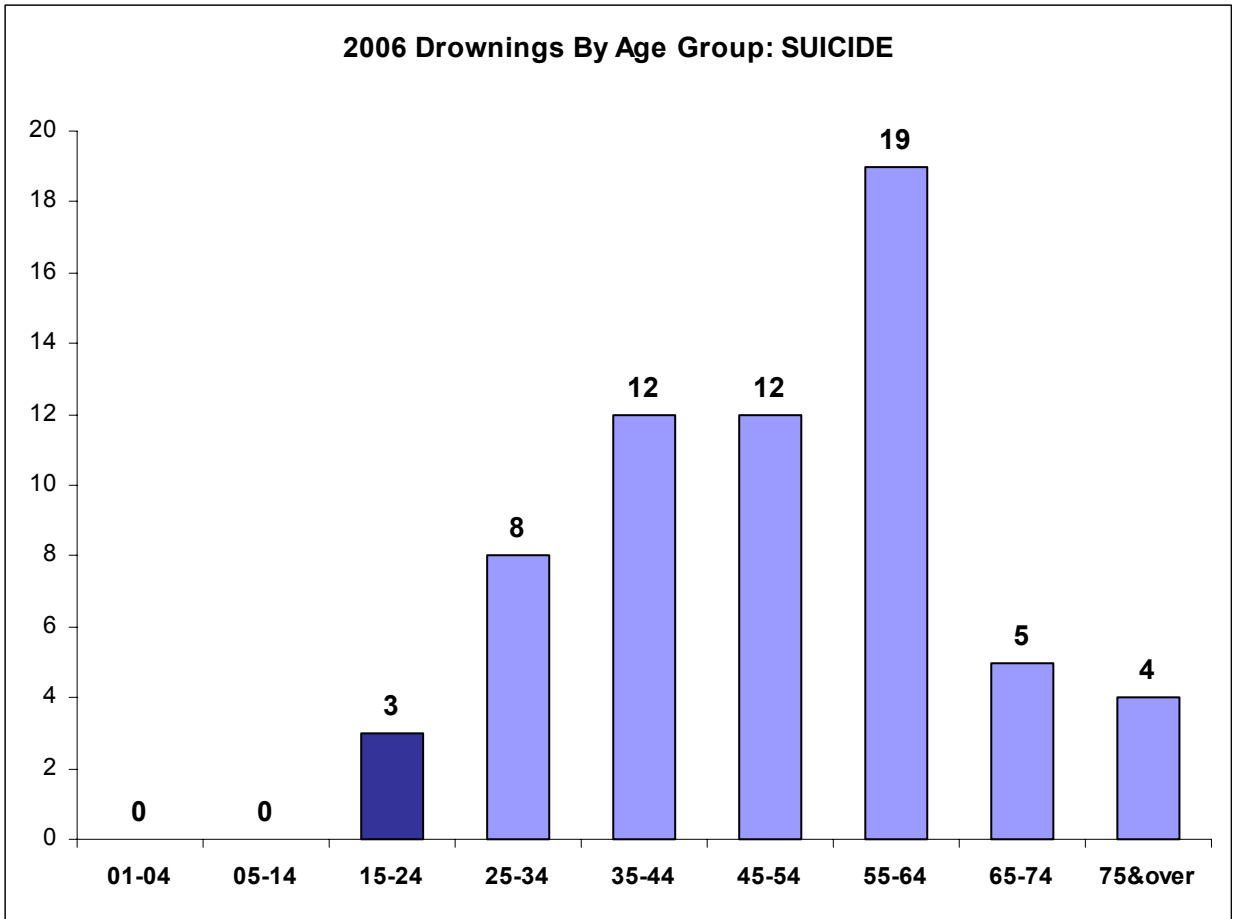
## Drowning Statistics 2006

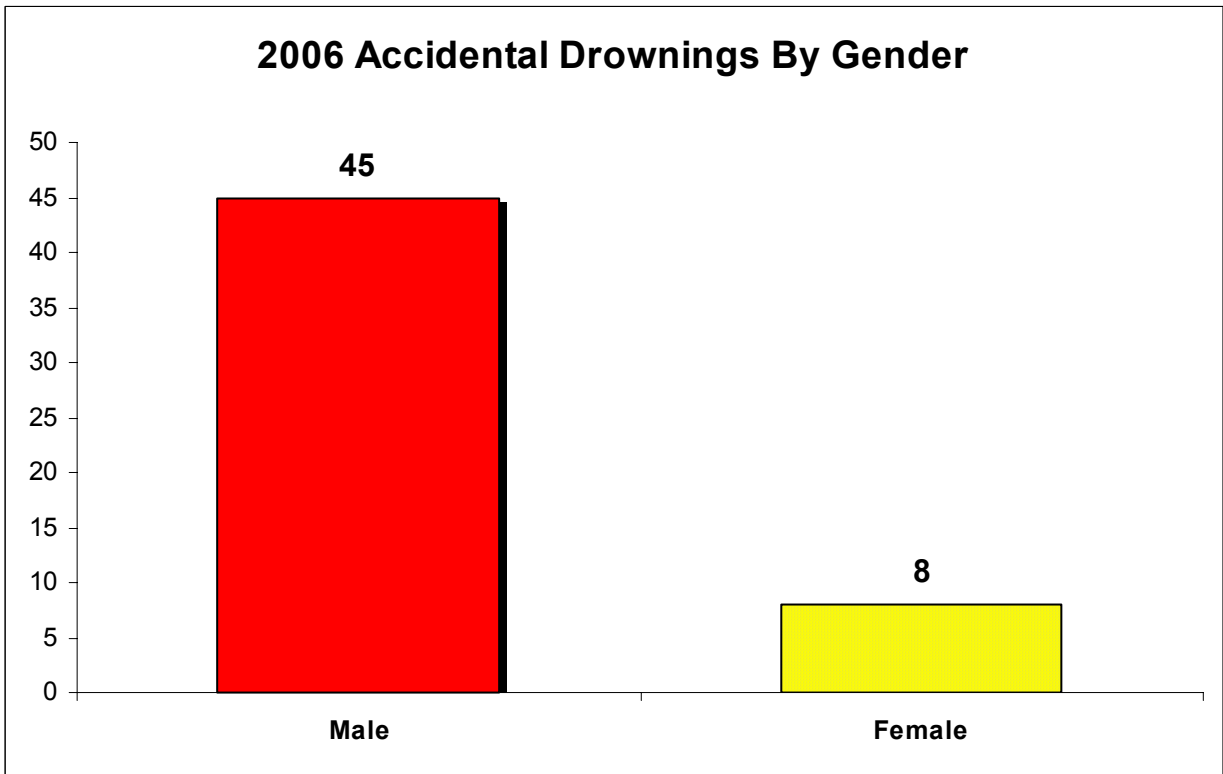
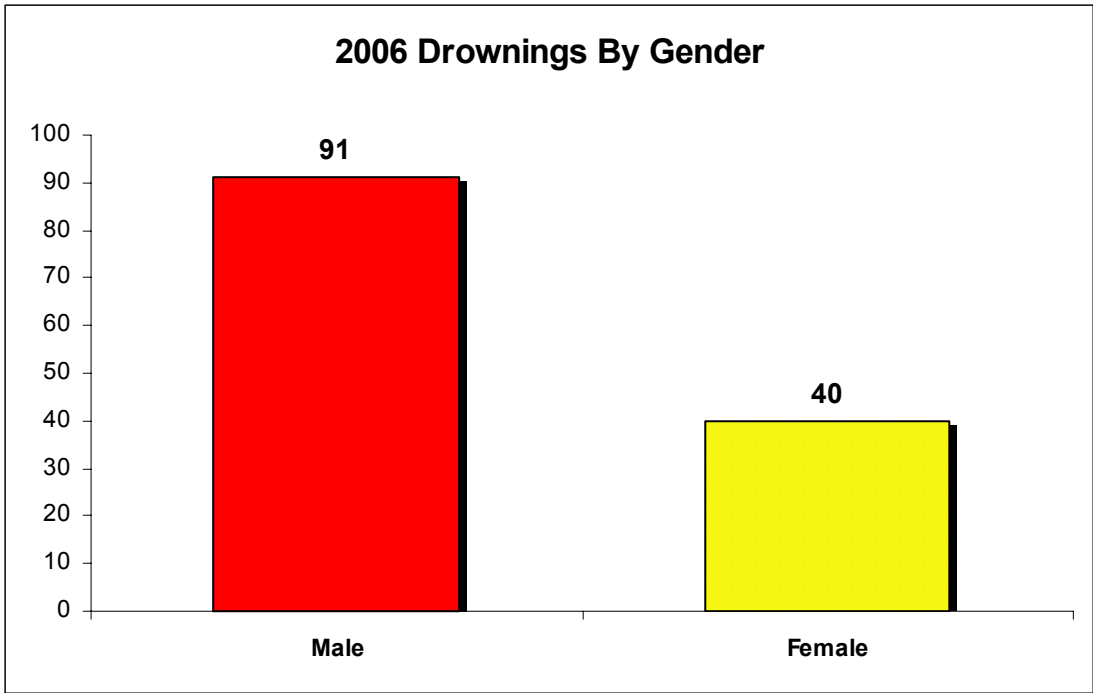
IWS maintains a comprehensive database of drowning incidents in Ireland. This database is constantly updated using information provided by the Central Statistics Office (CSO), An Garda Síochána and extracts from national and local media. Tragically in the year 2006 there were a total of 131 drownings. Note that the Undetermined Cause refers to 'Undetermined as to Accident, Homicide, or Suicide'.

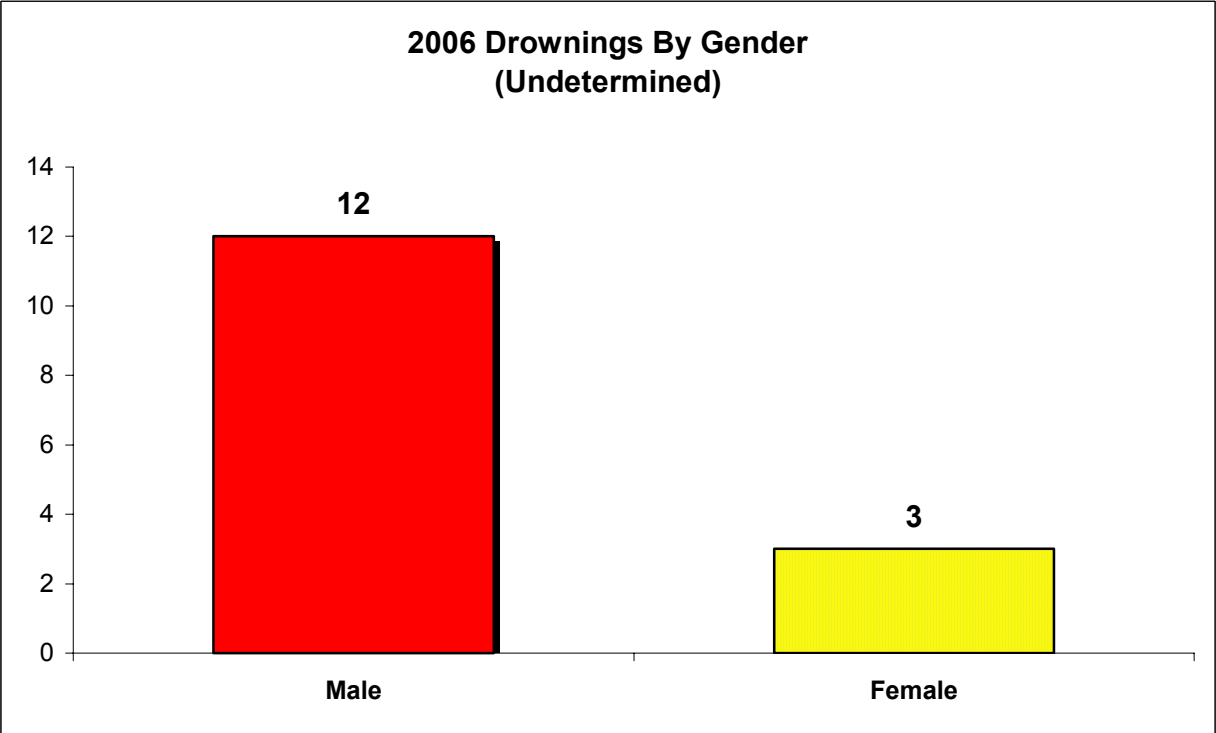
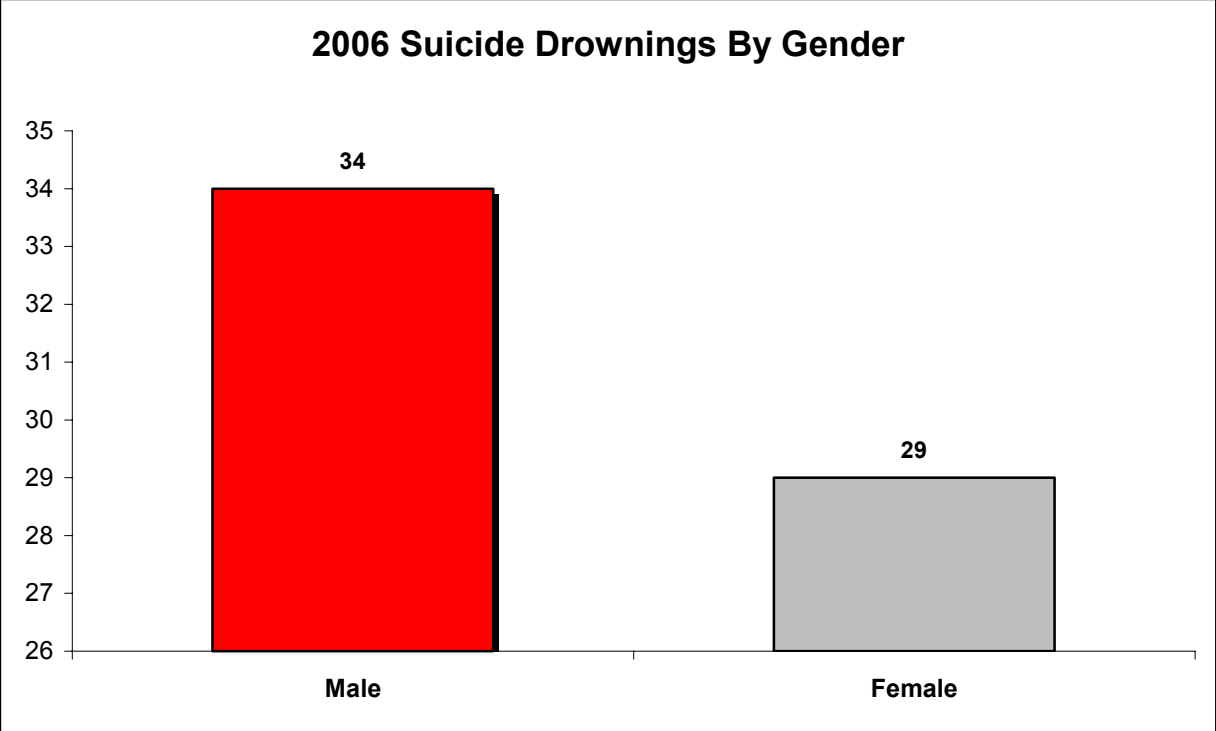


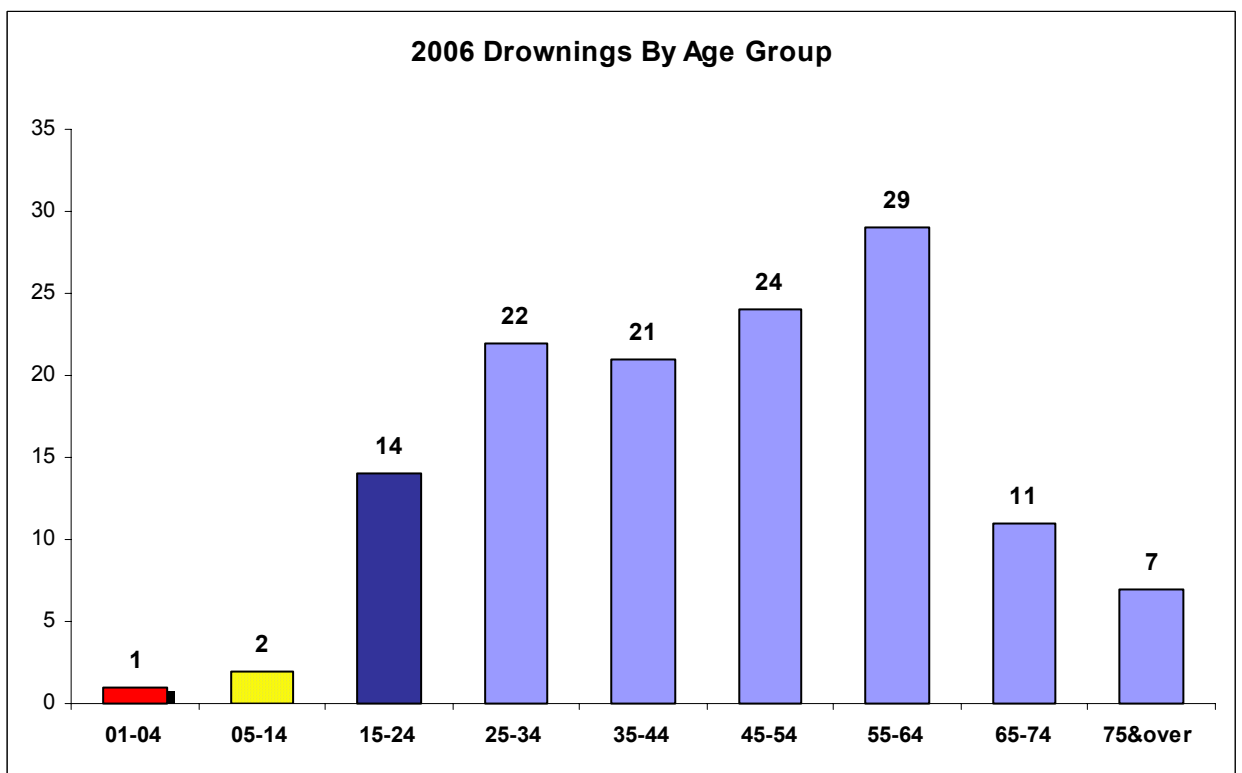
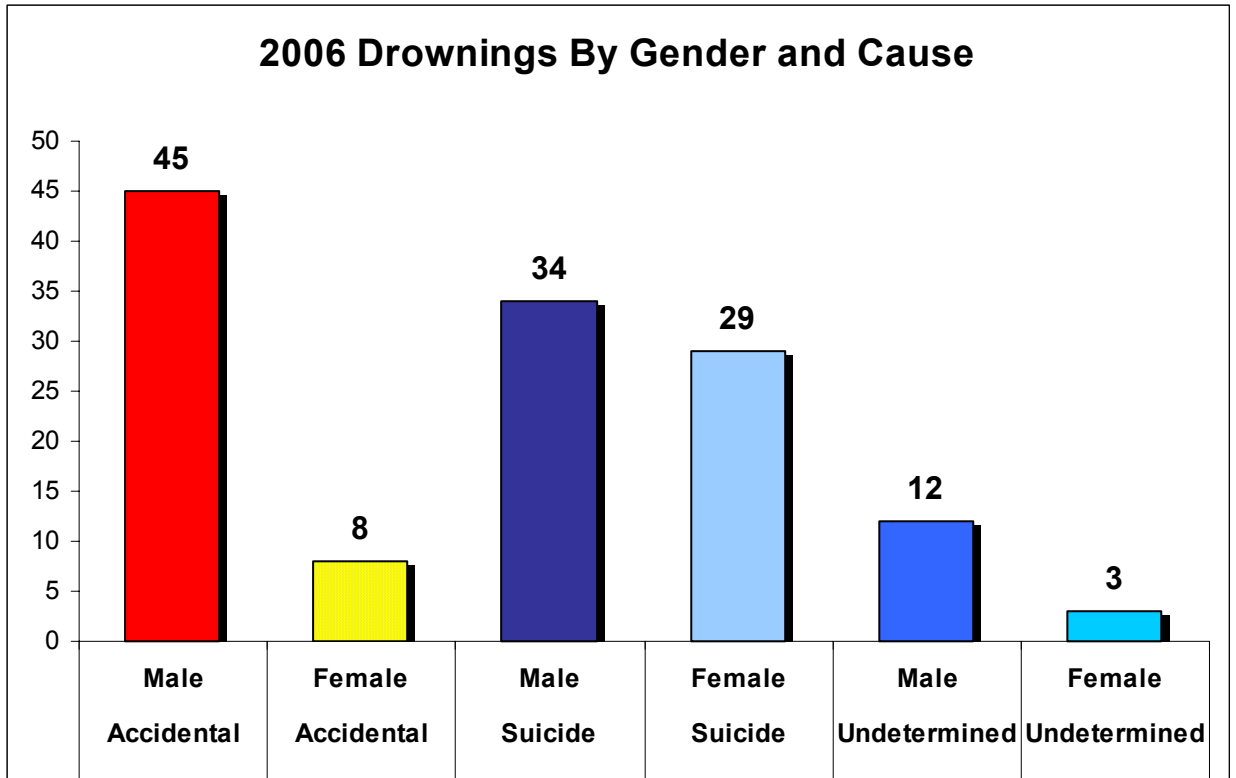
**2006 Drownings By Age Group: ACCIDENT**

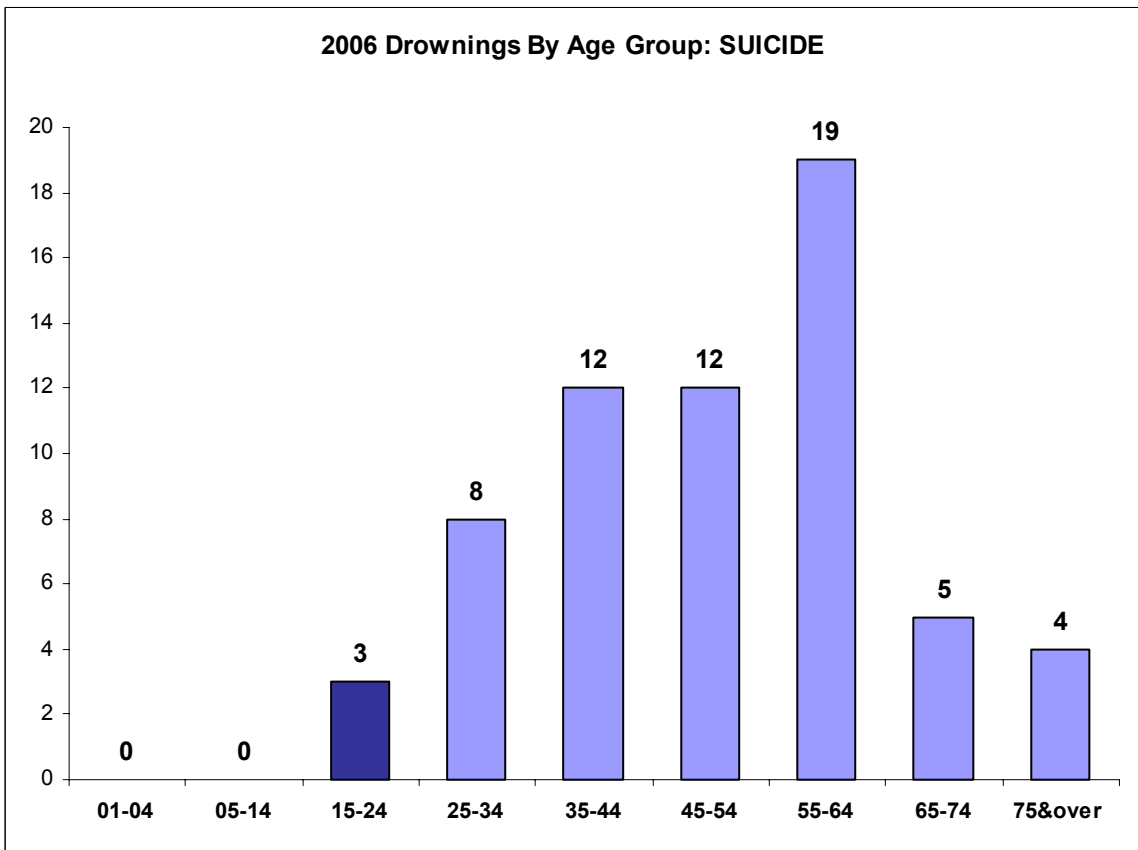
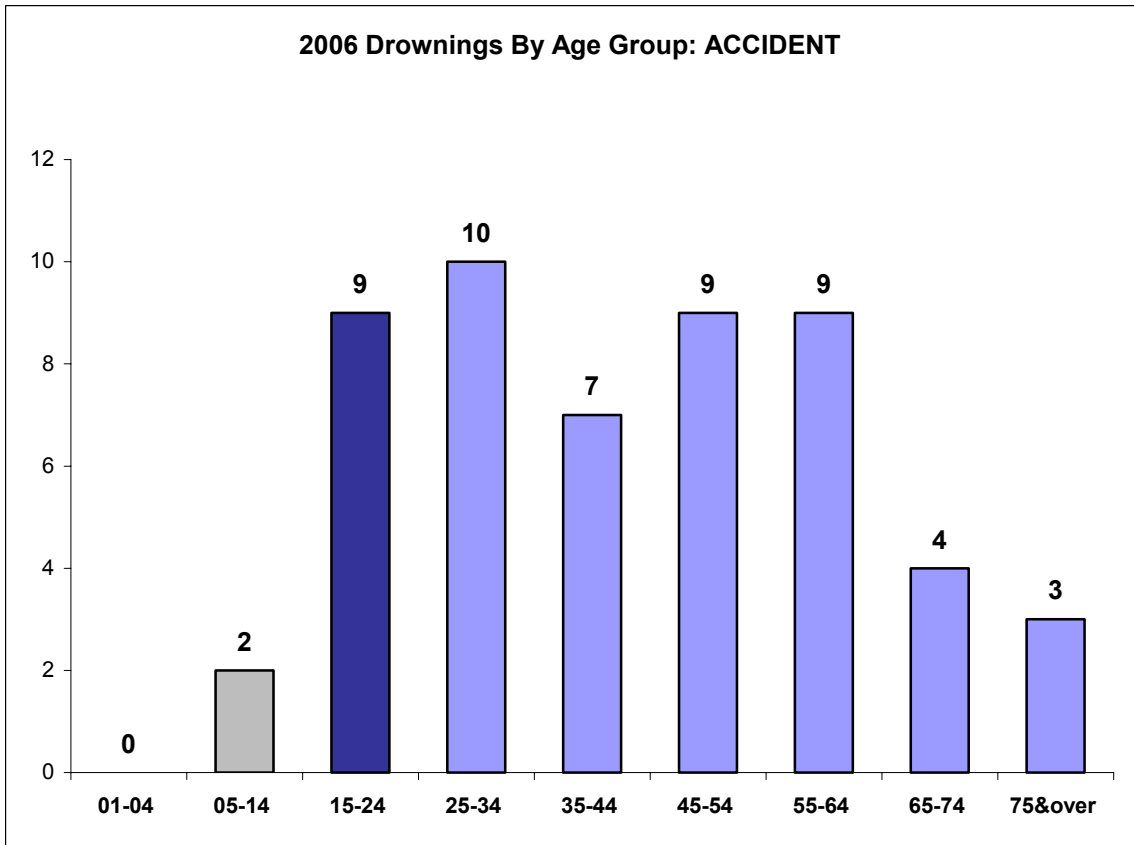


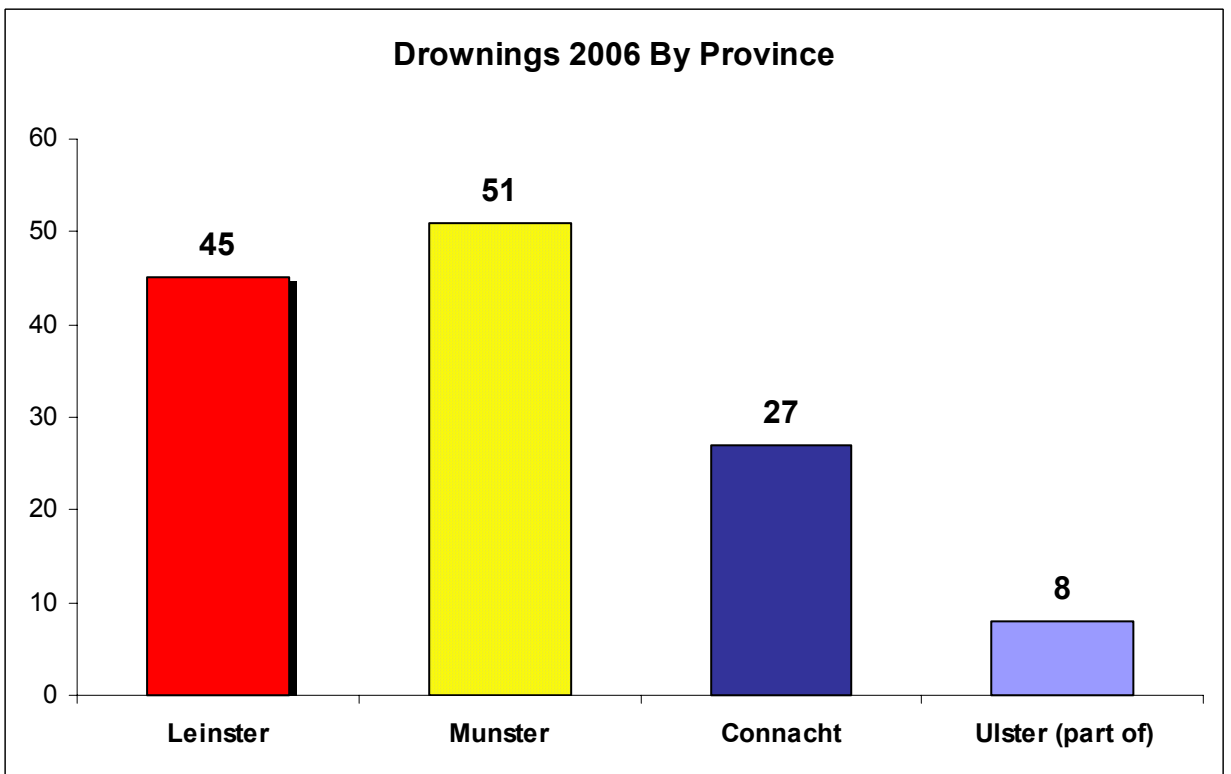
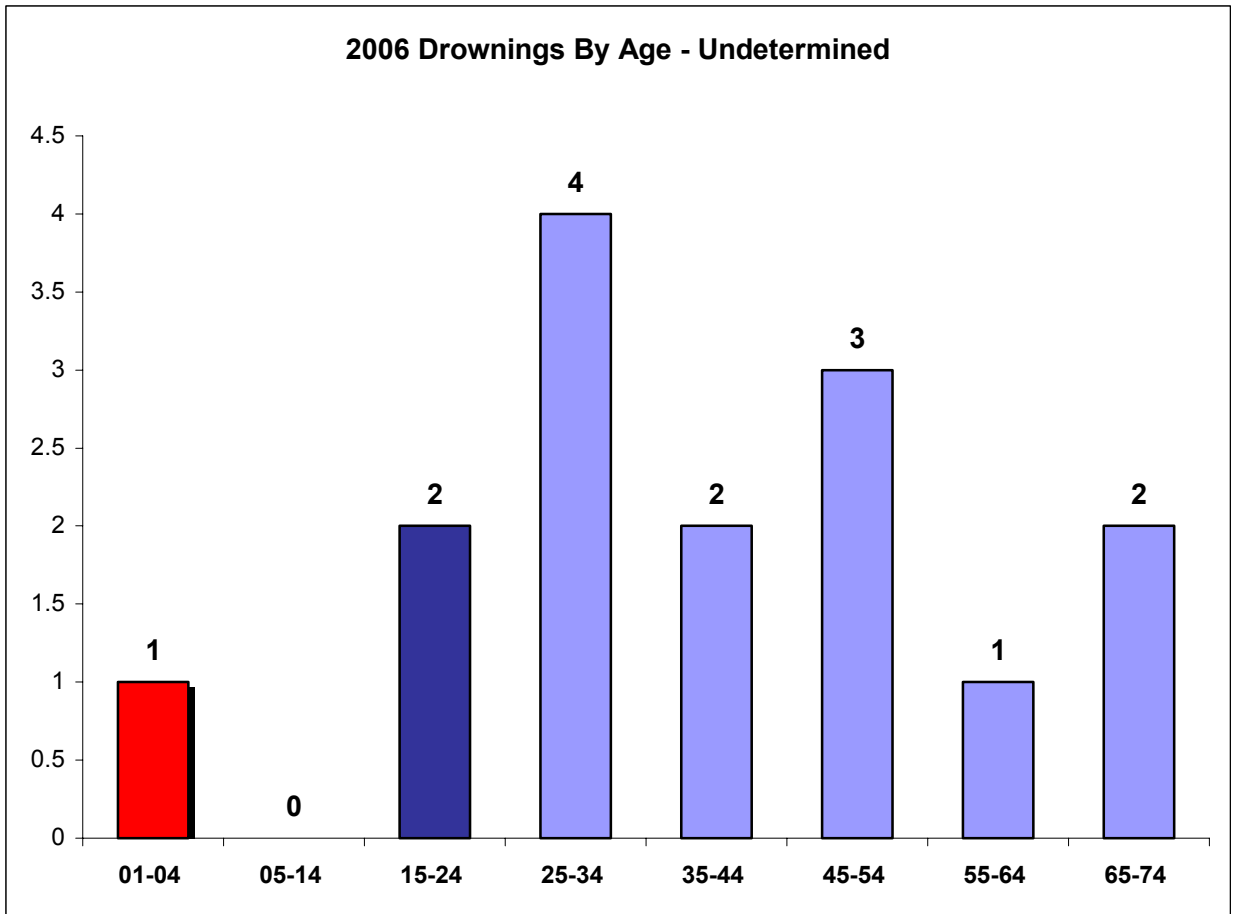






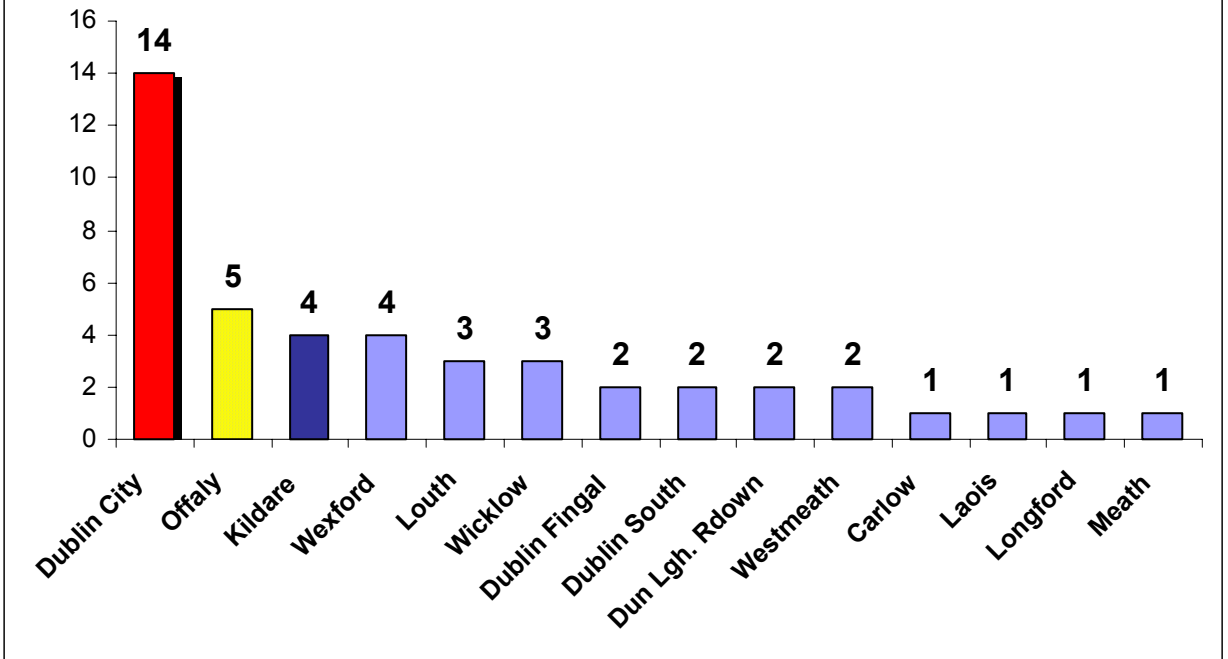
