PREREQUISITES: BLS 2

AWARD: Certificate.

VALIDITY: 2 years.

# **TEST ITEMS**

- 1. All skills and knowledge in BLS1 and BLS2.
- 2. Answer questions on knowledge of the circulatory system, the composition of the blood and the functions of the particles.
- 3. Candidates must satisfy the examiner on their ability to recognise a cardiac arrest.
- 4. Demonstrate effective skills to administer one operator, Cardio-Pulmonary Resuscitation (Child and Infant)
- 5. Demonstrate effective skills to relieve Airway Obstruction for conscious victims. (Adult, child and Infant)
- 6. Demonstrate effective skills to relieve Airway Obstruction for unconscious victims. (Adult, child and Infant)
- 7. Demonstrate effective skills to relieve Airway Obstruction when dealing with either pregnant or obese victims.
- 8. Answer questions on any aspect of Basic Life Support theory.

Candidates who pass the IWS BLS 3 Exam may also complete Test Items 2 – 6 of the CFR Community Award (Next Page) to be eligible for CFR Community Certification.
